SBBA Petition Urges Legislators to Save Louisiana's Future

1800 Signatures Support Restoring Funding to Higher Education

Shreveport-Bossier Business Alliance Executive Director Dr. Johnette Magner will be delivering petitions to each member of the Louisiana Legislature on Wednesday. The online petition to Save Louisiana's Future garnered over 1800 signatures from citizens concerned about the impending cuts to higher education.

The petition urges lawmakers to maintain funding for colleges and universities as the engines of the state's economy and critical to the fabric of communities around Louisiana. There is broad agreement across the institutions and among experts across the nation that if enacted, the dramatic budget cuts proposed in the executive budget will decimate the Louisiana higher education system and drive our students, our professors and Louisiana businesses to look elsewhere for opportunity.

The petition asks that that legislators work across the state and across the aisle to spare Louisiana from decline by forestalling the drastic cuts and instead invest in the future by fully funding the state's higher education institutions.
